### Soccer Skills

## MONDAYS

### Drawing Classes for Kids

*Presented by Young Rembrandts*

**GRADES: K-6TH**

Mondays, 2:50 – 3:50 • \$96 / 8 weeks

Back to school is in full swing as we present a bountiful selection of drawings that introduces our students to a fascinating world of color, pattern, and design. We say farewell to summer in our detailed still life drawing of a beach. We explore color usage and composition in our silly monster and fire truck drawings. Though associated primarily with Hawaii, the ukulele can actually provide students with the opportunity to play a diverse repertoire of music from all over the world. We will learn a bit about the culture and origin of each song we play.

OLQA school ukuleles are available for use during class time. For students who wish to practice on their own between classes, parents are welcome to purchase a soprano ukulele for their child to use. More detailed information regarding recommendations about where to purchase and which brand will be provided to those who enroll in this class.

Ukuleles are wonderful as solo and ensemble instruments and they provide a great way for students to sing and play at the same time!

## TUESDAYS

### Junior Coders: Computer Programming for Kids

Do you want to know how to make your own computer game? In this program, students will learn to develop computational thinking skills and build their own creative programs. This class will give students a strong foundation on coding basics and problem-solving that can be applied in regular classroom settings.

## WEDNESDAYS

### Dino-Robotics

As kids use infra-red remote controls, transmission gears and other electronic tools, they will develop thinking strategies, motor skills and dedication. Students will also have the chance to experiment in archeological digs, in which they will study fossils of a variety of dinosaurs. ### SEAL Robotics

## THURSDAYS
