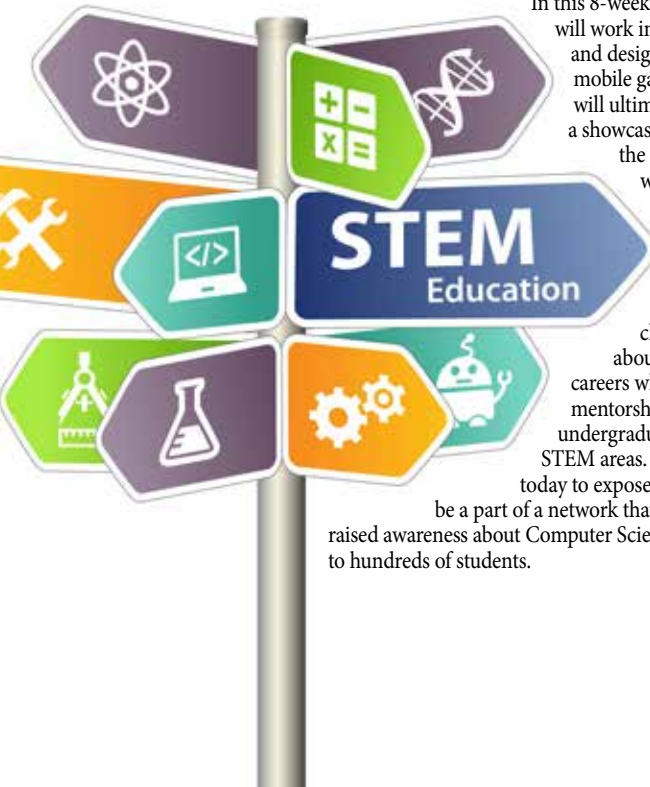
GRADES: 6TH-8TH
